THE RULES

The full list of Pool Rules are posted on the wall outside the Office. Please read them over and follow them carefully. If you have any questions, ask the life guard on duty.

NO RUNNING!

It is very important to remember NOT TO RUN in the pool areas. It is very dangerous, as someone could fall and slip into the pool unprepared or accidentally cause harm to another.

DIVING BOARD SAFETY

Only one person is allowed on the diving board at a time. All others, in line, must wait on the ground, not on the stairs, until their turn. Be sure to jump out far enough so that you don't hit the board! Non Swimmers, even in a life jacket or with a parent are not allowed on the diving board ever.

FLOATATION DEVICES

Only Coast Guard Approved Life Jackets are allowed in the pool. No other floating devices are allowed.

BAD BEHAVIOR

For the health and welfare of all who use the pool, the lifeguards will record names of children whose behavior has created a problem at the pool and notify the board immediately. Said children will be put on a supervised restriction list until the board sees fit to reinstate their privileges. Everyone needs to do his or her best to maintain a safe and happy pool environment.
